CMA Doctrinal Statement

The Christian Motorcyclists Association of Canada (CMA Canada) is a non-profit, interdenominational association of Christians who ride motorcycles. It is primarily an evangelistic outreach ministry to motorcyclists, rather than a motorcycle club. CMA is not a church.

We believe that the Holy Bible is the true and infallible word of God the Father; that it was written to give the human race throughout the ages, knowledge and understanding as to the purpose and fulfillment of living a Christian life.

We believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, born of a virgin, to bring fulfillment of salvation to a lost and dying world; that Jesus did many signs and wonders to fulfill the Scriptures, as proof of His authority; that Christ was crucified on a cross at Calvary and raised again on the third day, taking back the powers of death, hell and the grave.

We believe that only through acknowledging and repenting of our sins, and accepting Jesus Christ as our Lord and Saviour, may we be saved (John 14:6, Acts 4:12). This is our only escape from the eternal damnation of hell, and the way to the promise of eternal life, spent worshiping the Holy God by whom everything was created.

We believe in the Holy Spirit, the third person of the Triune Godhead, that He is ever present and active in and with the Church of Christ, convincing the world of sin, regenerating those who repent and believe, and indwelling Christians to enable them to live godly lives.

What is CMA?

The main purpose of this ministry is to share the Gospel with motorcyclists. This is achieved by attending motorcycling events, rallies and/or tours, developing relationships, offering support and skills as servants and conducting worship services. Thousands of people have come to Christ as a result of these efforts.

What CMA offers you

By combining our love for the Lord and motorcycling, CMA offers a great opportunity for **fellowship** with other members and CMA chapters through Christian rallies, rides and meetings. Our proven experience in the field of "highway and byway" evangelism has been used to develop training through our spring Seasons of Refreshing Conferences and the Ministry Team program. Other evangelistic training and material is available through the products of CMA's Tool Box items. The credibility and reputation CMA has earned through the years in the motorcycling world offers you **identification** with a group that has proven itself. Most of all, CMA offers you the **opportunity** to work with a respected motorcycling organization to open doors for the Gospel presentation to motorcyclists.

What CMA asks of you

The only requirement to be a member of CMA is that you be a Christian, having accepted Jesus Christ as your personal Saviour and Lord (please note the Plan of Salvation in this brochure). The Lord-ship of Jesus Christ defines personal, doctrinal, and moral decisions in the Bible.

After joining CMA, anyone who wishes to wear any item with the CMA Logo must first complete a CMA Ministry Team training course. When wearing the CMA Back Patch, we simply ask that your walk and testimony honour the Lord Jesus Christ.

We realize there are many levels of interest and involvement. Prayerfully consider how you want to be involved. Any Christian ministry with a strong foundation depends on people **committed** to its cause and **consistent** in their physical, prayerful and financial support.

CMA is supported by donations from individuals. We do not bombard mailboxes begging for money – we motivate by vision. Our existence depends entirely upon the prayerful, free-will contributions of the CMA membership. 10% of all undesignated income is tithed to other ministries to help spread the Gospel.

100% of the funds raised through the Run For The Son, CMA's annual benefit ride, goes to missions and evangelistic outreach. The Run for the Son is making a difference for the persecuted church by supplying it with much needed Bibles and study material. 30% of the Run for the Son money raised provides Bibles to "Restricted Access" countries through Open Doors with Brother Andrew. An additional 30% provides transportation for Pastors around the world allowing Christian leaders to expand into areas that are hard to reach. The remaining 40% is used for Outreach to motorcyclists through the Christian Motorcyclists Association of Canada, equipping members with the tools and training needed to spread the gospel message amongst the motorcycling community.
